

## **How to Apply for MESA UA Tuition Scholarships**

MESA has need-based tuition awards available for participating MESA seniors who plan to attend The University of Arizona. The value of the awards typically ranges between \$1500 and \$4000. In order to be considered for an award you must:

- 1. Have a Student Information Form (SIF) on file at the MESA Office by April 19, 2024.
- 2. Have submitted a complete Senior Survey by April 19, 2024.
- 3. Be admitted to the UA by April 19, 2024.
- 4. Have your FAFSA on file with the UA by April 19, 2024.
- 5. Commit to attend the UA no later than May 1, 2024 by submitting your enrollment deposit or application fee waiver request. For information about the application fee waiver contact your high school counselor or the MESA office at the number or email below.

The following criteria will be considered in the awarding of tuition scholarships:

- Information from MESA Senior Survey
- Years participating in MESA
- Financial need as determined by the UA
- Other tuition awards received from the UA
- Information from your University of Arizona Admissions Application:
  - o High School GPA & coursework completed, including rigor
  - o Personal statement
  - o Evidence of leadership in MESA and/or other organizations
  - o Community service or other indicators of involvement per your admission application
